



Crocheted Fruit Hammock

Materials:

Any size yarn will do, really - I used cotton

Hook to match yarn (on label)

[Command hooks](#) to hang hammock

Pattern:

Row 1: Ch-31, sc in second ch from hook and in each across, turn (30)

Row 2: Ch-6, tr in 3rd st, *ch-3, tr in 3rd st* to end, tr in last st, turn (30)

Row 3: Ch-6, fptc (see video^) around 1st tr from *previous* row *ch-3, fptc around next* to end, tr in the 3rd ch from the ch-6 from the *previous* row, turn (30)

Row 4: Ch-6, bptc around 1st fptc from *previous* row *ch-3, bptc around next* to end, tr in the 3rd ch from the ch-6 from the *previous* row, turn (30)

REPEAT Rows 3 and 4 alternatively until you reach desired length (mine is about 15" long)

Next row: ch-1, sc in each st across, turn (30)

Next row: ch-1, sc2tog all the way across, turn (15)

Next row: ch-1, sc2tog all the way across, sc in last, turn (8)

Next row: ch-1, sc in each st across (8)

Next row: ch-10 and sl st to opposite corner, creating a loop to hang

Attach yarn to the other end's hammock corner and repeat:

Ch-1, sc2tog all the way across, turn (15)

Next row: ch-1, sc2tog all the way across, sc in last, turn (8)

Next row: ch-1, sc in each st across (8)

Next row: ch-10 and sl st to opposite corner, creating a loop to hang

Weave in your ends and voila! You are finished. :D

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
