



Reversible Boot Cuffs

Materials

Any worsted weight yarn
Size hook indicated on label (I used H)

Gauge:

Doesn't really matter

Pattern:

Row 1: Ch-17, dc in third ch from hook and in each across. (15)

Row 2: Ch-1, turn. Sc in each (15)

Row 3: Ch-2, dc in each (15)

Alternate rows 2 & 3 until you reach desired length. Keep wrapping it around your calf, keeping in mind that you may be wearing jeans underneath them.



When desired length is reached, fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.



Putting wrong sides together, sew short sides in your preferred method. Turn right-side out.

For upper portion of boot cuff:

Find the seam and attach yarn by pulling up a loop. Sc in each st around, making sure you end with an even number of stitches (and don't do *too* many or it will balloon out. Try to stick with two per DC and one per SC). Join.



Row 1: Ch-1, sc in next st, dc in next. Repeat around and join to first with sl st.
Row 2: Ch-2, dc in first st, sc in next. Repeat around and join to first with sl st.
make sure your dcs are going into the scs of the previous row and the scs are going into your dcs of the previous row
Alternate rows 2 & 3 until desired height is reached. Fasten off and weave in ends.
